
Martin Wong (M. Div. [High Honours], Oral Roberts University) Pastor (Missions)



Helping Youths from Challenging Backgrounds

Through the generous donations from HOGC members, Heart Community Services (HCS) has given out \$334,000 in financial aid and scholarships to over 180 members and their families in the past year.

Established in 2008, HCS provides financial and educational support, as well as social services to the local community. With HCS, young people in our church facing financial challenges receive pocket money, opportunity grants and scholarships.

GenerationS Transcends Borders and Cultures

Global Chinese Alpha Conference

Alpha has impacted more than a million people worldwide. Thousands of pastors and leaders gathered at the Global Chinese Alpha Conference to be inspired, equipped and empowered for the global Chinese community.

During one of the sessions, Pastor How shared the message of GenerationS and for those eager to delve deeper, GenerationS Vol.1 in Chinese was made available. We also hosted a follow-up session at our church where Pastor Lia imparted key principles on discipleship.



GenerationS Across Thailand

God has opened many doors for the message of GenerationS to impact Thailand. In March, a HOGC team shared at the Great Commission Alliance (GCA) Camp attended by key pastors and leaders across the country.

The following month, we sent a team to Congress 9, a once-in-5-years conference organised by all the major Christian denominations and movements in Thailand. Each of the 5,000 pastors and leaders present was resourced with a copy of GenerationS Vol. 1 in Thai. Today, the message of GenerationS lives on through the book and a documentary produced by the Thai National Committee.

Later in the year, our youth leaders also conducted training sessions for over 200 youth leaders from churches in Bangkok.
Running everything from service operations to worship, they shared principles from the GenerationS book and personal testimonies of empowerment in our church.

Reaching the NextGen in Indonesia

Pastor Garrett brought a team and shared the GenerationS message at Youth Alive, Australia's largest Christian youth movement focused on training and nurturing future youth pastors across the country. Many responded to the call and were inspired to build GenerationS in their churches.

Bringing Transformation to the Latin American Church

HOGC supported Reverend Emilio Reyes, Vice President for OneHope (Latin America) who ran conferences in Guatemala and the Dominican Republic. GenerationS was so well-received, leaving a significant impact on many attendees.

Continued Support for Destiny Grace Home Orphanage in Myanmar

Over the last 17 years, HOGC has supported Destiny Grace Home (DGH), an orphanage in Myanmar. Through the years, our mission teams have made multiple visits for various purposes – from providing means for the orphanage to foster the children's holistic development to serving the needs of the local community.

Helping Ukraine's Youth & Homeless

Since the start of the crisis in Ukraine, HOGC has been providing fast and timely support for our Ukrainian friends and their families.

Our ongoing financial aid to Ukraine churches and Christian humanitarian organisations has helped with:

- Securing buses for evacuation of women, children and orphans
- Procuring essential medical supplies for hospitals
- Providing food and necessities to the elderly and young people
- Setting up shelters for the homeless and needy
- Assisting in smooth resettlement of refugees

In addition, our pastors and youth leaders have initiated Zoom calls with the Ukrainian youths to pray with them and provide comfort and encouragement during these difficult times.



Heart of God Church (HOGC) was founded in 1999 by Senior Pastors Tan Seow How (Pastor How) and Cecilia Chan (Pastor Lia). Pastor Lia started the first teens group with 9 youths, which grew to thousands of young people, including our next generation of homegrown senior pastors.

Across the church, the average age is 23 and young people lead and run virtually everything. We believe that youth are leaders today, not just tomorrow.



Board Governance

Board of Directors for FY 2022-2023:

- Elected at the 24th Annual General Meeting (AGM) held on 4 Dec 2022
- Serve on a voluntary basis and receive no remuneration or benefits for their board services
- Hold regular board meetings (once a quarter) throughout the year to attend to the affairs of the church. All directors attend board meetings unless they are overseas.

The CEO of the HOGC Group manages the business, finance and operations of the group through the General Managers of the church and the subsidiaries, and is accountable to the HOGC Board.

These shareholders hold their shares on trust for HOGC by way of a Trust Deed. They receive **no profits or benefits** for their respective roles.

There are no loans or bonds between HOGC and its subsidiaries.

How does HOGC use its Finances?

General Fund

This helps HOGC's operational needs, which includes running in-person and online services.

Heart Community Services

Established in 2008, Heart Community Services (HCS) is a fund that provides financial, education and social services to the local community.

Through HCS, pocket money, opportunity grants and scholarships are disbursed to young people from less well-to-do backgrounds, or whose families are going through a financial crisis.

Missions Fund

Our Missions Fund supports the local and overseas mission work of HOGC. We partner with organisations that have projects which make lasting impact. These include providing humanitarian assistance and aid to disaster relief work.

Building Fund

As HOGC does not have premises of its own, the Building, Equipment and Rental Fund (BF) is necessary to cover the rental, maintenance and renovation expenses of its current premises, as well expenses to secure future premise(s). It is funded by the members of HOGC through a voluntary pledge fulfillment.
